

## **UFo Triple TnT Results**

### **May 29, 2011**



### **Jeremy Miller and Ron Delano Jr. Conquer Hesston Speedway and 'Motor Mountain'**

**Hesston, PA (May 29, 2011)** On a hot sunny day at the Dave Eriksen owned Hesston Speedway in Hesston, PA, 45 UFo Super Late Models were on hand for the tour's first ever appearance at the facility dubbed 'Motor Mountain'. Two, \$2,000 to win UFo 25-lap main events were on tap with Gettysburg, PA's Jeremy Miller claiming the first main while Ron Delano Jr., of Stoystown, PA captured the finale before a record crowd for the speedway.

Ron Delano Jr., and Matt Parks of Three Springs, PA led the first feature to the green flag with Delano Jr., setting the pace for the first circuit before the first of two cautions came out for the slowed car of Shippensburg, PA's Jerry Bard. When racing resumed, the standard UFo double file restart put Jeremy Miller in the hunt as he was able to work his way around both Delano Jr., and Parks to grab the lead before the second and last caution of the event was displayed. During the caution period, fourth running Jason Covert, York Haven, PA, was forced to go pit-side with a flat right rear tire but would return in time to tag the field.

The action picked up again with Miller continuing to lead as eleventh starting Devin Friese of Chambersburg, PA worked his way into the fourth spot behind the leaders. Miller set a torrid pace around the 4/10 mile oval while the battle for sixth between the father/son combo of Jim and Dylan Yoder. The two raced side by side for a number of laps before Dylan eventually secured the spot. The intensity picked up as the laps wound down as J.T. Spence of Winchester, VA and Parks battled hard for second while thirteenth starting Austin Hubbard from Seaford, DE, piloting the familiar Dale Beitler owned, Reliable Painting sponsored entry, began to reel in Jim and Dylan Yoder to join in the battle for sixth.

As the laps ticked away, Spence and Parks continued to battle for the runner-up spot behind Miller, who would lead the rest of the way for the \$2,000 win. Spence used the low line to finally work his way around Parks to finish second followed by Parks in third, Friese in fourth, and Dylan Yoder rounded out the top-five finishers. Jim Yoder held on for sixth with Hubbard seventh, Lewistown, PA's Nick Dickson eighth, Jeff Rine, Danville, PA ninth and Gregg Satterlee was tenth.

After pulling an invert number of eleven in Victory Lane, the first feature winner, Jeremy Miller would have to start 11th on the grid for the second 25-lap feature event. Ironically, Ron Delano Jr., who finished 11th in the first feature, found himself on the pole again for the second feature event with Gregg Satterlee, Rochester Mills, PA on the outside of the front row. The two brought the field to the green flag with Delano Jr., again jumping out to the early lead with Satterlee and Dickson in tow.

With Delano Jr., leading the way, Hubbard battled with Jeff Rine for the fourth spot while Dickson worked his way past Satterlee for the second position. Dickson then set his sights on the race leader and by lap seven, was right on the rear deck-lid of Delano Jr. Dickson tried the low line on the leader and was able to almost pull alongside of Delano Jr.'s brand new Victory Circle Chassis but couldn't make it stick as Delano Jr. held off Dickson's rally.

Dickson continued to stalk the race leader as Hubbard and Satterlee battled for the third spot. Satterlee was doing all he could on the bottom half of the speedway but Hubbard used the momentum of the high side to keep Satterlee behind him. The laps began to tick away as Delano Jr. slowly started to inch away from Dickson while Hubbard started to gain on Dickson. With three laps remaining, Hubbard was able to make his way past Dickson for second but the pass was short lived as Dickson dove into turn three to regain the spot from Hubbard in lapped traffic. With Dickson and Hubbard racing each other, Delano Jr., was able to cruise to the victory leading all 25 laps for a \$2,000 payday. Dickson finished second with Hubbard third, Satterlee fourth, and Dylan Yoder finishing fifth for the second time. Jeff Rine was sixth followed by Jim Yoder in seventh, Jim Yoder eighth, Matt Parks ninth, and South Park, PA's Jared Miley rounding out the top ten.

Preliminary winners included Nick Dickson, Dylan Yoder, Jason Covert, J.T. Spence, and Jeremy Miller. Consolation winners were Jared Miley, and Jerry Bard.

### **Rance Garlock Holds off Craig Wagaman In Late Model Sportsman Thriller at Hesston; Henney, Norris, Lauffer & Moore All Hesston Winners.**

HESSTON, PA (May 29, 2011) – An overflow crowd saw an action packed night of racing at Hesston Speedway on Sunday night. Rance Garlock picked up a cool \$1000 in a thrilling win in the Late Model Sportsman feature. Bill Henney captured the Street Stocks while Terry Norris grabbed a win in the Hobby Stocks. Shawn Moore (Mod 4's) and Mike Lauffer (Factory 4's) shared four cylinder wins.

In the 25-lap Late Model Sportsman feature Craig Wagaman grabbed the initial lead from the pole starting spot. Wagaman looked like he was way to victory but a determined Rance Garlock kept pecking away and reeled in the leader. Garlock battled with Wagaman for many laps before taking the lead. Garlock then started to pull away until he caught up to lapped traffic. This allowed Wagaman and Grant Adams to narrow the gap on Garlock. Wagaman pulled along side with two to go as Garlock made contact with a lapped car. The pair were door handle to door hand through the final two turns. As they came out of turn four they had a drag race to the finish with Rance Garlock securing his second straight LMS feature win. Wagaman was second over Adams, Tim Smith Jr. and Justin Kann. Eric Irvin, Wagaman and Garlock secured heat wins.

The Street Stock 18-lap feature saw a few lead changes before fifth starting Bill Henney was able to take the win. Greg Moore led at the start. Moore, Dave Brown and Henney put on a show for the fans as they battled for the lead. Once out front Henney then cruised to second straight checker. Brown, Brian Duffy, Moore and Ken Singer were the top five. Brian Duffy and Jesse Snyder were the heat winners

It appeared to be all Terry Norris in the 15-lap Hobby Stock feature. Norris grabbed the lead from his outside front row starting spot. Norris never gave it up but had to hold off a strong challenger from last weeks winner Rick Potter. The finish is pending a post race inspection of the #73 Camaro of Norris'. Potter through everything he had at Norris but came up short to finish second over Chad Gambol, Curtis Guyer and Jake Gongloff (from 15<sup>th</sup>). Sixth through tenth were Carl Snare, Todd Goss, Andy Los, Derek Graybill and Brad McGinnis. Heat wins went to Potter and Gambol.

In the Mod 4 15-lap feature event it was Shawn Moore picking up his second consecutive feature win. Ken Hill was second followed by Frankie Gordon, Gary Newell and Eric Seibert.

Mike Lauffer improved on his second place finish on opening day in the 12-lap Factory 4 Cylinder feature. Lauffer started fifth and passed Justin Williamson to take his first win of the season. Williams was second ahead of Steve Fredrick, Ryan Claycomb and Denny Norris. The four cylinders only ran feature events.
